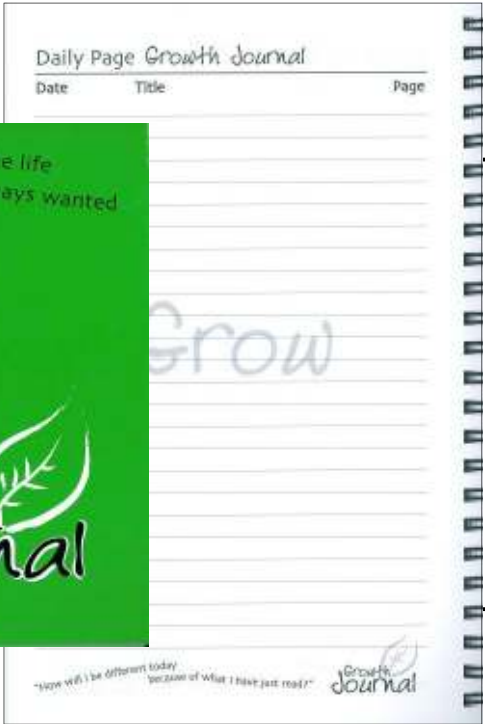

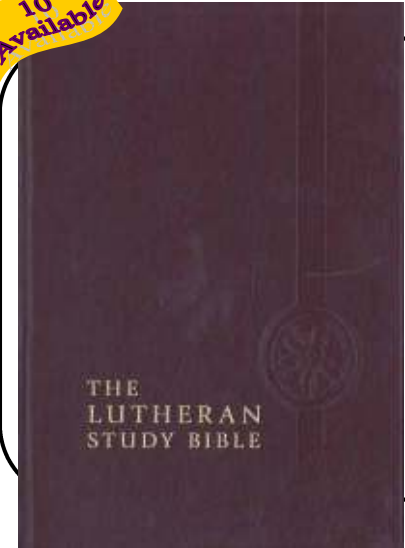

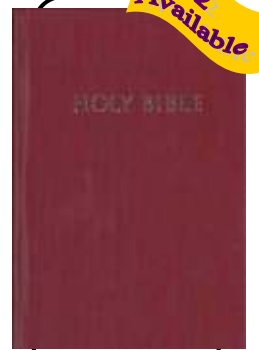
Growth Journal \$5.00

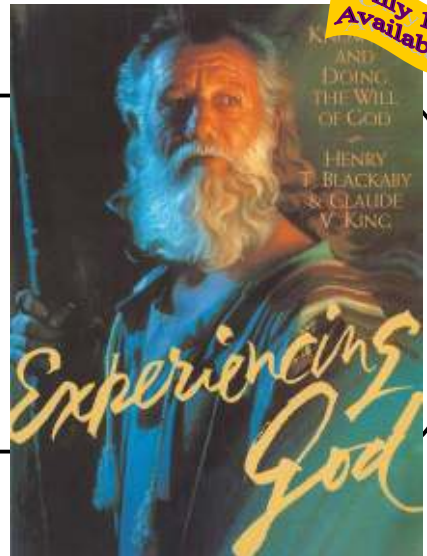
The Lutheran Study Bible - ESV \$75.00

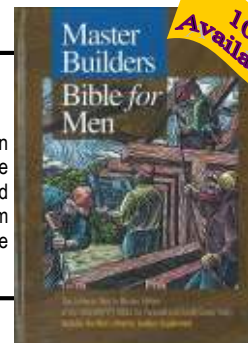

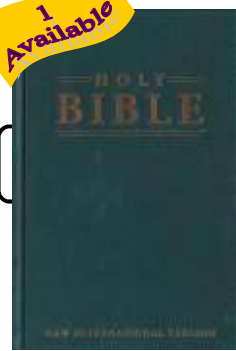
Experiencing God: Knowing and doing the will of God \$10.00

- And many more...

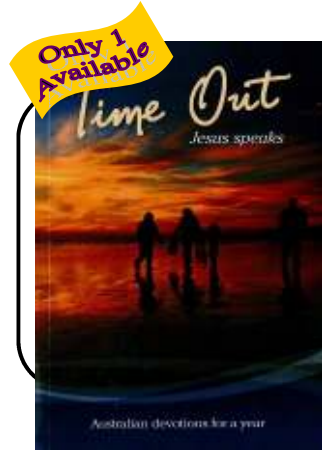

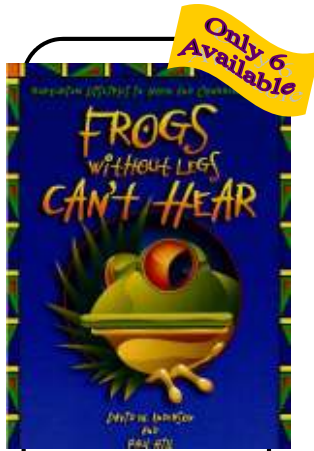
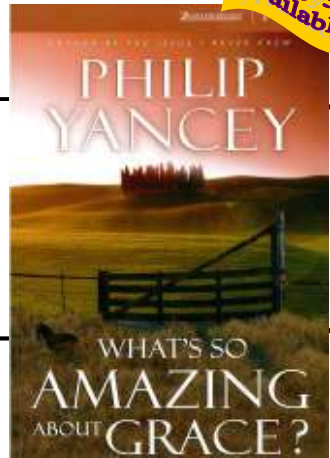
Reclaiming the "L" Word

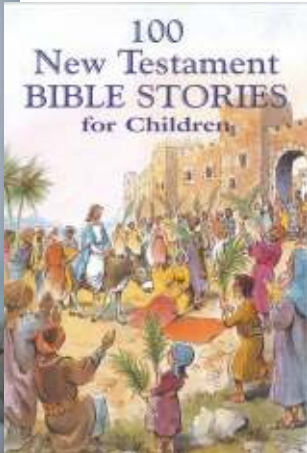
Time Out/Jesus Speaks Devotion Book
